We support you so that you and your child feel safe in our facility and has the same rights as all other families and children.

We therefore do not tolerate discriminatory and deliberately offensive behaviour. We intervene in the case of inhuman, derogatory or threatening statements. We remain alert to our own prejudices and evaluations.

We do not allow any signs that conflict with the equality of all people. Organisations that are opposed to equal coexistence may not be advertised.

- a positive contribution to their living conditions,

In our facility, all adults commit themselves to treat everyone with respect. We also help your children treat others with respect and affirm diversity.
